5. Successfully complete ICS-400 Advanced ICS for Command and General Staff – Complex Incidents (G400).		
6. Complete a minimum of 40 hours of classroom training in Search and Rescue management. Classes which may be used to satisfy this requirement include but are not limited to:

13. Document mission practical experience: a) Function as a Type II Search Manager on at least ten ground missions within the five years prior to making application for this certification. Simulations may not be counted toward meeting this requirement.		
14. Participate as an Incident Staff Person in Operations in at least two type two incidents.		
15. Participate as an Incident Staff Person in Plans in at least two type two incidents.		
16. Receive a favorable written performance evaluation from the Search Manager (SM) or Agency Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) on four incidents.		
17. Be proposed for ASRC Search Manager I by a ASRC Search Manager I at an ASRC Board of Director's business meeting.		
18. Receive a simple majority vote of the member's group.		
19. Receive a favorable two-thirds or greater vote of the members present at an ASRC Board of Director's meeting.
